CAP CADET PROGRAM

This manual supplement prescribes additional procedures in effect for all Wisconsin Wing CAP units. Full understanding of this supplement may only be obtained by reading it in conjunction with the related paragraphs of CAPR 52-16.

CAPR 52-16, December 1998 is supplemented as follows:

3-5 Awards.

- a. Added. Satisfactory completion of a CAC term is defined as attending 50% of all scheduled CAC meetings, and satisfactorily completing any

5-3 Authority. Added. The Encampment Commander will report as a member of the Wing Chain of Command to the Cadet Programs Directorate.

(2) Encampment Visits:

By non-attending cadets and senior members will be on a limited, non-interference basis. The visits must be coordinated through the Encampment commander a minimum of two days prior to the anticipated visit date.

Visits will be limited to between 1000-1600 Hrs. and be of one day duration. No overnight stays permitted. No use of the Volk Field mess hall will be allowed.

WIWG Command Staff, WICP, WIIG or their designated representatives are exempt from the aforementioned limitations. Accommodations and mess privileges are on a space available basis. Prior arrangements will be made through the Encampment Commander.

Names and CAP #'S of visitors will be provided to the Encampment commander for referral to the Security Police at the main gate.

Due to increased security precautions visitors must be prepared to show a photo ID and CAP Membership Card at the main gate. Vehicles are subject to search. Non CAP members cannot enter the base.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Defines satisfactory completion of a CAC term, and clarifies the position of Encampment Commander's standing as a wing staff member in the chain of command.

Supersedes WIWG Supplement 1, 1 April 1999.
